Once on the website, it is on the "Contact" page near the bottom. Also on that page is a list of the Covenant Committee members and ways to contact the TIA.

The 9 page form is under "Electrical Inspections Form and Information" and you can take a look at "Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Installation- Baltimore County Requirements" which has bulleted information, contractor and inspector checklists, and information for the electrician.

You can call (410-887-3960) to discuss any of the following topics as they are crucial in any solar panel project:

- having a licensed electrician
- electrical guidelines
- the fire code
- placement of the solar panels
- for larger projects, buildings would need a building permit

In addition, electricians are required to take photos of the project for Baltimore County. Other critical components to consider by the installer include the following: placement, having a limited number of panels (which is a more recent development compared to the past where some houses have the entire roof covered), and ** fire code regulations***.
